

## Mt Somers Holiday Park policies

Arrival: Arrival Time: 2 pm unless stated otherwise. Accommodation will be held up until 4pm on the day

of arrival unless a full night's deposit has been received, or prior arrangements are made.

Departure: 10 am

Deposits: A deposit of one night's tariff paid by cash, cheque or credit card (Visa/Mastercard) will confirm a

reservation.

Cancellation: Deposits will be refunded if cancellation is made at least 3 days prior to arrival date. Exceptional

circumstances will be taken into consideration.

Accounts: Balance of accounts are payable on arrival, or online when booking. Payment must be made for the

full time booked.

Refunds for early departure are at the management discretion. Refunds will only be

considered in exceptional circumstances.

Alcohol: Alcohol is only permitted to be consumed on your allocated site. Excessive drinking and parties are

forbidden.

Barbecues: No solid fuel barbeques allowed. Accelerants are not to be used in ANY circumstances.

Caravans: Including campervans must have an electrical warrant of fitness and comply with NZS3001:2008

and LPG Standard (NZS 5428:2006). All campervans and caravans must have their own wastewater

container. Chemical toilets must be emptied in dump stations.

**Children:** Children to be controlled and supervised by parents at all times.

Conduct: Reasonable guietness between 10.30pm and 7am. Some discretion is allowed on New Year's Eve.

Reasonable behaviour and dress at all times. Excessive drinking and parties are forbidden.

Damage: Cost of damage to property or accommodation will be recovered.

Gang Insignia: Gang Insignia including patches must not be worn or displayed in the Park.

Parking: One vehicle to be parked on own site only. Parking is not allowed on driveways.

Pets: Must be pre-arranged with management, and on a lead at all times. Not permitted in cabins.

**Rubbish:** To be recycled or wrapped and placed in receptacles provided.

**Speed:** Vehicle speed in park is limited to a walking pace only (5KM).

Tents: Electricity can only be connected through an approved isolating transformer or RCD Safety Switch.

Visitors: Visitors are allowed by arrangement with the management. Your visitors are your responsibility

and should depart by 10pm. Visitor's vehicles are to be left outside the park or in visitor's car

park. Any charge for visitors, if not paid, will be your responsibility.

We ask for your co-operation so that your stay and the stay of other guests can be enjoyable.



Breach of any of these rules, Health & Safety or Fire Regulations may result in you being required to leave the park immediately without refund.
